MICHELIN 295/75R22.5 and 285/75R24.5 Dimensions

- This Technical Bulletin addresses the introduction of 295/75R22.5 and 285/75R24.5 dimensions in Michelin, BFGoodrich and Uniroyal commercial truck tires. Michelin has historically designated our low-profile 22.5 and 24.5 dimensional offers as 275/80.
- The move to the new dimension will make our products consistent with the North American tire industry and simplify the dimensional offer for our customers.
- The transition is starting with the following dimensions listed below. The dimension change for other tire lines in the Michelin, BFGoodrich and Uniroyal portfolios will be made as products are updated.
