GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS - X® MULTI™ 2022 ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE GUARANTEE

1. DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this guarantee, the following definitions apply:

Accidental Damage means any accidental damage that occurs to a Tyre (defined below) that has been used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines in the correct conditions of use for the Tyre that is not repairable and makes the Tyre unusable. For the avoidance of doubt, Accidental Damage does not include damage caused by mechanical defects of the vehicle, road traffic accidents, mechanical incidents, defective tyre repairs, acts of vandalism, fine renarral diseases:

Beneficiary means an End User who has purchased new Tyres from a Professional Tyre Distributor or purchased a new vehicle fitted with such Tyres, between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022 (inclusive) in the ROI:

Credit Note means a credit issued by Michelin in accordance with the terms and conditions of this guarantee for Accidental Damage to a Tyre and provided to a Professional Tyre Distributor for passing on to the Beneficiary;

End user means a company that conducts its haulage business using a fleet of HGVs that it owns and manages at its own cost; and

Professional Tyre Distributor is a professional tyre distributor with a direct account with Michelin in the ROI.

2. TYRES COVERED BY THE X® MULTI™ GUARANTEE

3. ELIGIBILITY AND LIMITS OF THE X® MULTI™ GUARANTEE

- 3.1. This guarantee only applies to Tyres that incur Accidental Damage between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022. Michelin's decision on what constitutes Accidental Damage is final.
- 3.2. Tyres are covered by this guarantee until half-worn, in compliance with the original depths of rubber stipulated in the calculation referred to below
- 3.3. The DOT number (format WWYY) appearing on the sidewall of the Tyre must show the tyre to be within four years of the date of manufacture at the time of dails. For example, a tyre manufactured in the first week of 2019, with a DOT code of 0119 would be within 4 years from manufacture up to the first week of 2023. If there are any oureier selation to DOT numbers olesse refer to your Michelin recreasentaive.

4. PROCEDURE AND REIMBURSEMENT

- 4.1. The Beneficiary must purchase the Tyre between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2022
- 4.2. If the Beneficiary believes that the Tyre is damaged in accordance with the definition of Accidental Damage, the Beneficiary must log noto MyPortal and identify the damaged Tyre in question from a list of eligible products and select the relevant Professional Tyre Distributor they wish to use to process the quarantee claim. Each claim must be accompanied by photographic evidence of the Serial Number, DOT number, and damage area in question for the tree relained.
- 4.3. Provided that the claim meets the conditions set out in this guarantee and cannot be repaired and the Professional Type Distributor accepts the claim, a Credit Note will be issued by Michelin to the Professional Type Distributor in accordance with the calculations set out in the table below relating to the tread remaining on the damaned Type.
- 4.4. The Professional Tyre Distributor will then pass the Credit Note on to the Beneficiary
- 4.5. The Beneficiary must send the damaged Tyre to the Professional Tyre Distributor within 7 days.
- 4.6. By accepting the procedure for Michelin to process the claim, the Beneficiary accepts the transfer of ownership of the damaged Tyre to Michelin.
- 4.7. Michelin will examine the damaged Tyre on receipt of the Tyre from the Professional Tyre Distributor to confirm that the damage is covered by this guarantee. Michelin will monitor the Beneficiary's use of this guarantee and if Michelin determines that the damage is not covered by this guarantee or that the remaining tread calculated by the Beneficiary is incorrect, Michelin reserves the right to exclude the Beneficiary from making claims under this guarantee Michelin's decision on this is final.
- 4.8. The Credit Note is established on the basis of the reimbursement of a lump sum per Tyre calculated according to the following scale:

The remaining tread depth, in accordance with the table below, is:

- equal to or greater than 90% of the OTD Credit Note: 100% of Reference Price;
- less than 90% but no less than 50% of the OTD Credit Note: 75% of Reference Price;
- less than 50% of OTD No Credit Note applicable.
- 4.9. The Beneficiary is kept informed of progress by processing the claim on MyPortal.
- 4.10. For the avoidance of doubt, the cost of service operations in connection with Tyre replacement are met by the Beneficiary (for example, travel, call-out charges, removal and replacement costs etc.).

5. GENERA

- 5.1. The Beneficiary's statutory rights are not affected by the terms of this guarantee.
- 5.2. The issue of any Credit Note under this quarantee is not an admission of liability by Michelin.
- 5.3. Michelin shall have no responsibility for any further damage or costs which may be incurred.
- 5.4. Michelin reserves the right to modify/remove this guarantee at any point with immediate effect by updating these terms and conditions on MyPortal.
