When does the Agilis HD Grip D tire launch?

June 1, 2024 – US

July 1, 2024 – Canada

What sizes will the Agilis HD Grip D tire be available in?

- 225/70R19.5 LRG 18/32-MSPN 79805
- 245/70R19.5 LRH 19/32-MSPN 68242

What are the key benefits of the Agilis HD Grip D tire?

All-Season Performance – The tire is engineered to provide reliable traction and handling in various weather conditions, including rain and snow, ensuring year-round driving confidence.

Traction – Navigate with confidence, excellent grip, and control

Durability – Built to withstand the demands of the streets with a tough, retreadable casing.

It also can be used in certain on/off-road applications.

Is this product 3PMSF rated?

Yes. The Agilis HD Grip D tire was designed as a traction-oriented product for all seasons, and it meets the requirements to be marked 3PMSF for severe snow traction.

Can you retread the Agilis HD Grip D tire and what are the retread products?

Yes, the Agilis HD Grip D tire is retreadable. Michelin Retread Technologies has many products that fit these 19.5" casings, but popular drive tire retreads include: MD XDN2, XDS2+, XDE M/S, and XDHT.

Does the Agilis HD Grip D tire have a warranty or a guarantee?

Yes, this tire has the 20% more mileage satisfaction guarantee⁽¹⁾ and the 60-day satisfaction guarantee⁽¹⁾.

Is the Agilis HD Grip tire for the drive or steer position and what is the recommended use?

The Agilis HD Grip D tire was developed to withstand the torque of a drive position and provide excellent traction through all seasons. In some regional and on/off road applications, this tire can be used in all positions, especially on 4X4 vehicles.

What vehicles is the Agilis HD Grip D tire suitable for?

It is suitable for Class 3-6 Work trucks, examples include Box Trucks, Low Cab forward work truck and box trucks, Step Vans, and tow trucks.

They are small and large fleets, with the following vocations: last mile delivery, goods and food delivery, utility, government, ambulances, and service.

How does the Agilis HD Grip D tire compare to other tires in its class?

The Agilis HD Grip D tire is a competitive traction-oriented drive tire. We believe in its performance, so we provide a 20% more mileage guarantee⁽¹⁾ on the mileage performance and a 60-day satisfaction guarantee⁽¹⁾. Additionally, this tire provides up to 35% better snow traction performance than leading competitors.⁽²⁾

Where is the Agilis HD Grip D tire manufactured?

Is it manufactured exclusively in our North American plants in Spartanburg, SC.

Guarantee will pay in the form of a credit for the difference of your acquisition price per tire. Credit will be issued and all documentation must be validated by a Michelin Sales Representative.

Michelin reserves the right to modify or discontinue this program at any time for any reason without prior notice. All claims must be made by December 31st of the current year. See your local Michelin dealer or sales representative for more details.
