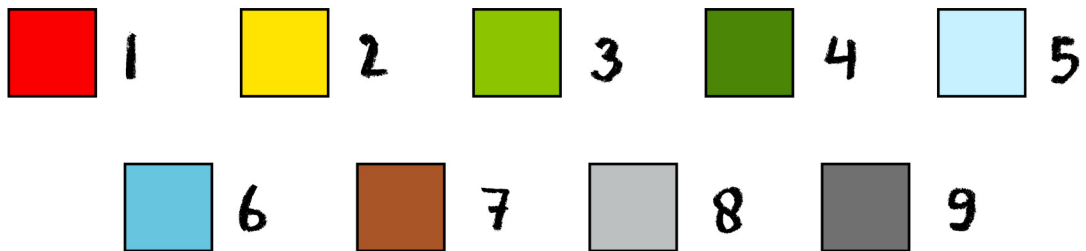
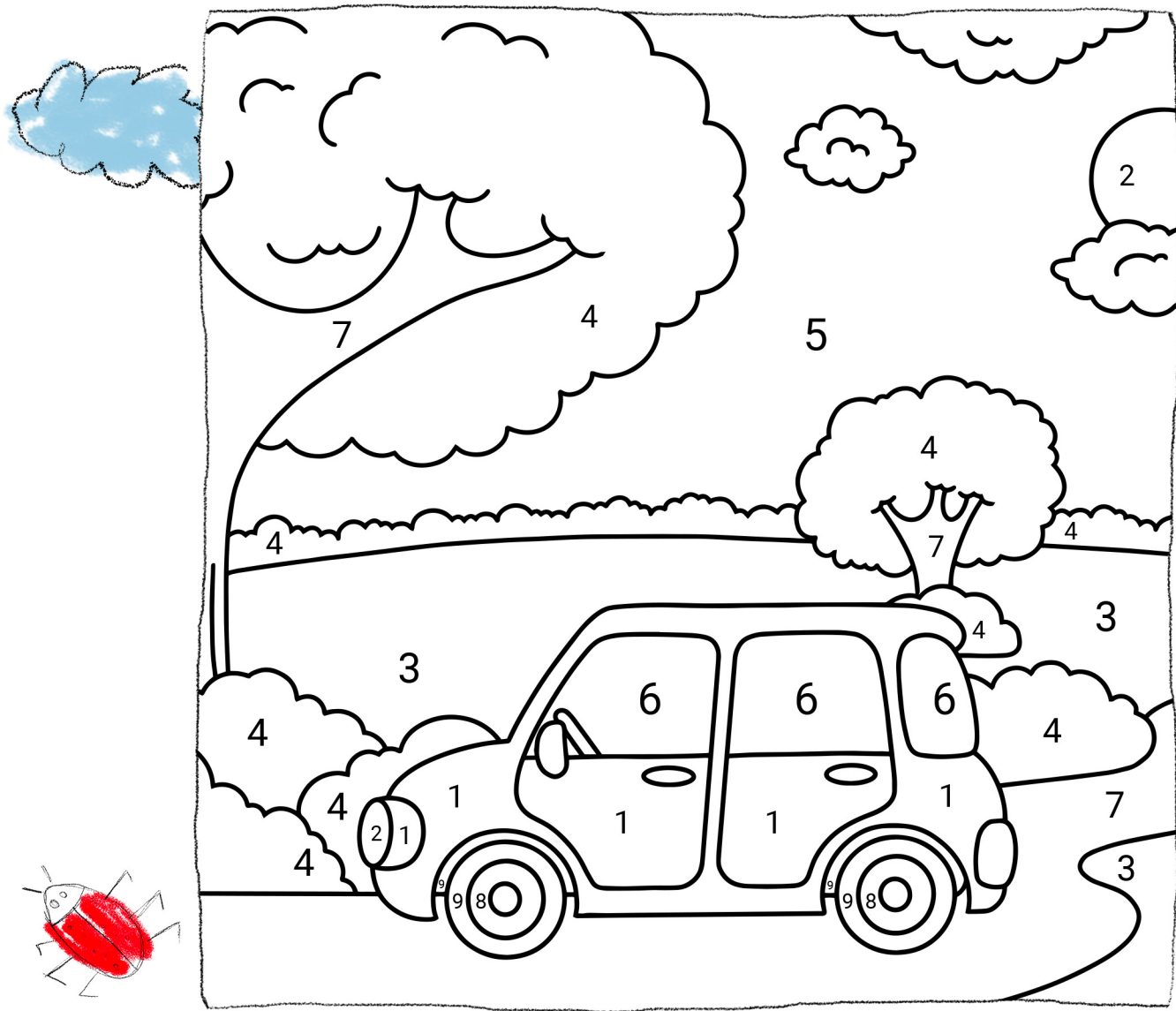
Come Spring, the road enjoys new-found colour as nature awakens. And you, are you awake enough to spot the differences between these 2 drawings?
