MICHELIN & SPA-FRANCORCHAMPS

- » Michelin has won the 6 Hours of Spa-Francorchamps with Peugeot, Audi and Toyota, but never with Porsche
- » Michelin won the 1,000km of Spa-Francorchamps every year from 2002 to 2011
- » Michelin has won the 24 Hours of Spa-Francorchamps 13 times. The race was first held in 1924, a year after the inaugural Le Mans 24 Hours
- » Michelin launched its 'Hybrid' intermediate tyre at the 6 Hours of Spa-Francorchamps in 2012
- » Michelin has won at Spa in the Formula 1 World Championship, the Sportscar World Championship, the FIA WEC, the European Le Mans Series, the BPR, the FIA GT Championship and the Blancpain Series, etc.

- » 30 years ago, Michelin won the 1989 480km of Spa with Baldi/Acheson (Sauber-Mercedes C9)

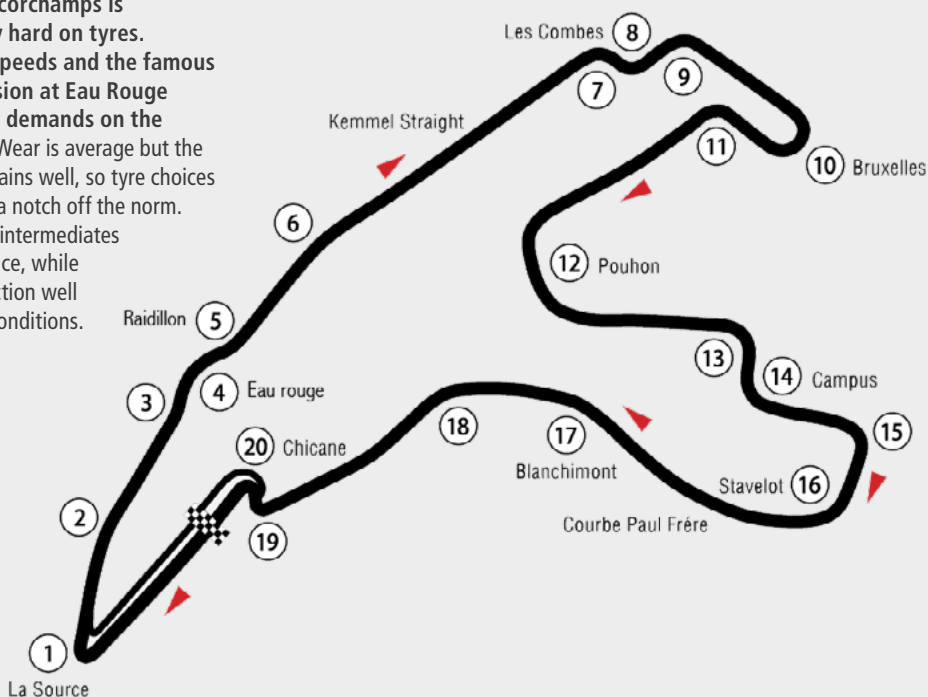

FEATURES

Spa-Francorchamps is relatively hard on tyres. Its high speeds and the famous compression at Eau Rouge make big demands on the casings. Wear is average but the surface drains well, so tyre choices are often a notch off the norm. If it rains, intermediates often suffice, while slicks function well in damp conditions.

- » The infamous 'Raidillon' was created 80 years ago, in 1939

"Spa-Francorchamps is one of the hardest circuits for tyres due to the high aerodynamic loads the teams run and the high speeds reached by the cars. It is a common belief that if our tyres work at Spa, they will also suit Le Mans, a month later. The 2019 race is a bit special because it is the 2018/2019 championship's second visit to the Belgian circuit with the same tyres we took there last May. We will have medium- and hard-compound slicks for our LM P1 and LM GTE partners, while the LM GTE Am runners will be able to choose from soft, medium and hard slicks. We will obviously have intermediate and rain tyres as well, because the weather can be unsettled in the Belgian Ardennes at this time of year."

THE 2018 RACE

- » **Winners:** Buemi/Nakajima/Alonso (Toyota TS050 Hybrid/Michelin), 163 laps
- » **Pole position:** Buemi/Nakajima/Alonso (Toyota TS050 Hybrid/Michelin), 1m54.962s
- » **Fastest race lap:** Mike Conway (Toyota TS050 Hybrid/Michelin), 1m57.442s
- » First endurance racing win for Fernando Alonso
- » A Toyota/Michelin one-two
- » After qualifying on pole position, the N°7 Toyota/Michelin had to start the race from the pit lane
- » Three different makes (Ford, Porsche and Ferrari, all Michelin partners) on the LM GTE Pro podium

SPA-FRANCORCHAMPS TRIVIA

- » Spa has been a famed spa resort since Roman times
- » Europe's first casino – La Redoute – opened in Spa in 1762
- » The original 14.981km circuit inaugurated in 1921 formed a triangle that linked the towns of Francorchamps, Malmedy and Stavelot
- » The original track hosted a Formula 1 grand prix for the last time in 1970 and its last prototype race in 1975



- » In 1973, Henri Pescarolo set a new lap record at an average speed of 262.46kph driving a Matra 670B

FIA WEC SPORTING REGULATIONS

FIA WEC grid orders for six-hour races are based on the average best qualifying times of each car's two nominated drivers (except at Le Mans).

Starts take the form of rolling starts after a formation lap.

To be classified, a car must cross the finish line and complete at least 70 percent of the distance covered by the race winner.

POINTS-SCORING SYSTEM (SIX-HOUR RACES)

- 1st, 25 points.
- 2nd, 18 points.
- 3rd, 15 points.
- 4th, 12 points.
- 5th, 10 points.
- 6th, 8 points.
- 7th, 6 points.
- 8th, 4 points.
- 9th, 2 points.
- 10th, 1 point.

Other finishers, 0.5 point
Pole position: bonus point (Drivers and Manufacturers)

Non-hybrid LM P1 and LM P2 cars: 3 types of slick for the season for all the cars / 2 types of slick to be nominated 48 hours before the Prologue test / 2 types of slick for each race (from the above 3) to be nominated 48 hours before the start of scrutineering (3 types of slick for Le Mans).

LM GTE Pro and LM GTE Am: 3 types of slick per model for the season / 2 types of slick to be nominated 48 hours before the Prologue test / 1 additional type of slick can be registered in the course of the season / 2 types of slick for each race (from the above 3) to be nominated 48 hours before the start of scrutineering (3 types of slick for Le Mans).

INTERMEDIATE AND RAIN TYRES

Can only be used if Race Control declares the track to be wet (free practice, qualifying, race). No quotas per race.

FIA WEC TYRE REGULATIONS

LM P2: 1 type of intermediate tyre and 1 type of rain tyre for the season for all cars entered 48 hours before the Prologue. The re-cutting of tread patterns is not authorised.

LM GTE Am: 1 type of intermediate tyre and 1 type of rain tyre per model entered 48 hours before the Prologue. The re-cutting of tread patterns is not authorised.

In the course of the season, a competitor may change tyre brand no more than once.

Penalty: a 3-minute Stop&Go penalty for tyre regulation breaches

A maximum of 4 mechanics and 2 tyre guns for wheel changes during pit stops. Tyre changes may now be carried out while the car is being refuelled.

1 tyre technician is authorised to carry out a visual inspection of the tyres and check their pressures.

Tyre changes are only authorised a) on the grid up to the three-minute board, b) in front of the car's garage during a pit stop or inside the garage in the case of longer work on the car, c) on the track if the race is suspended.

Tyres are identified by RFID chips and bar codes. All tyre serial numbers must be communicated to the Technical Delegates 48 hours in advance.
