STARTING FROM SCRATCH

The last time Michelin raced on Belle Isle Park in Detroit was in 2008. This means this year's Detroit race will mark a fresh start for all involved.

"We have no history with our current generation of tires to go by in Detroit. So, we start from scratch. That's the biggest angle," said Ken Payne, Technical Director, Motorsport, Michelin North America.

"We might as well consider that we've never been here. They are new cars and a completely different generation of tires from when we were last here."

"The temperatures are all over the road map. It'll be one where we're paying attention to data as we gather it in real time, and figuring out adjustments and where they need to go on cambers and pressures."

"It's a brand-new race for us. We get fairly limited track time sprinkled throughout the day, so the time of day for practice and qualifying might not be as relevant to the race."
