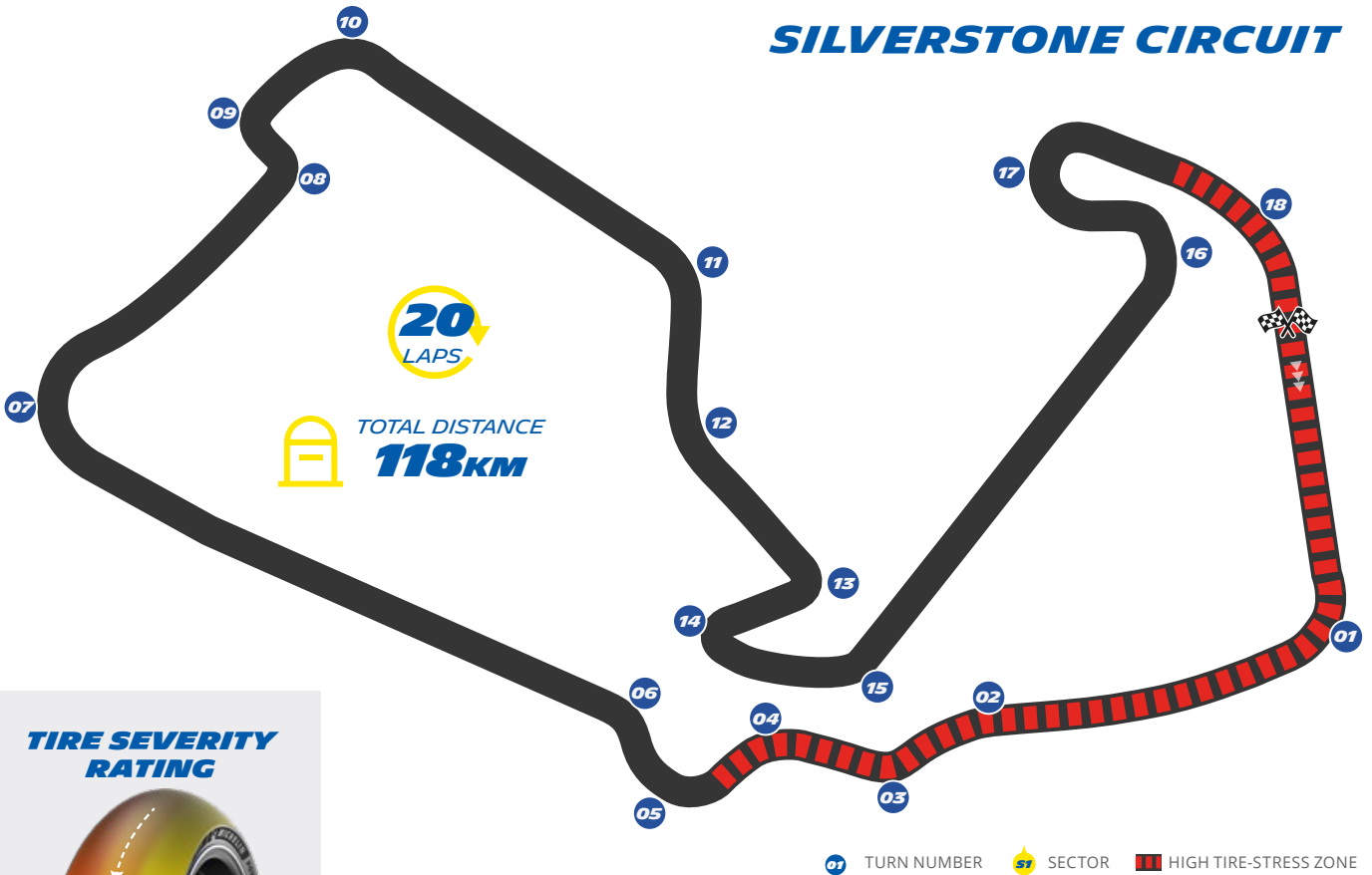

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tire will be allocated.

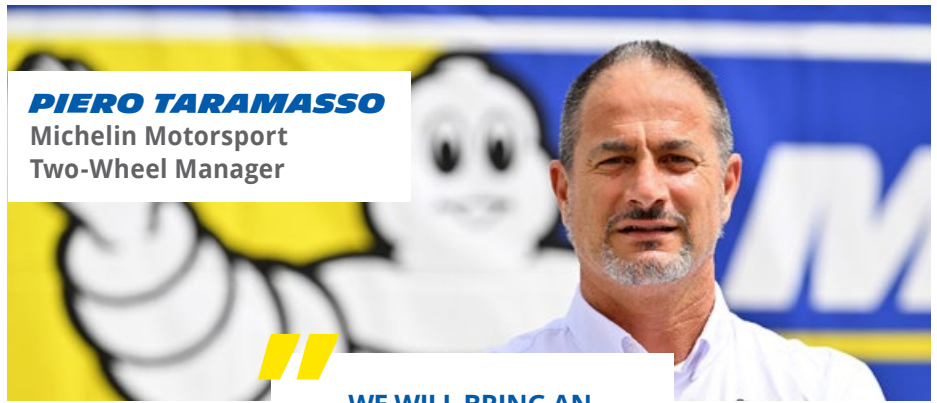

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes:
7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

WE WILL BRING AN ALLOCATION OF TIRES THAT CAN NOT ONLY RESIST THE HEAT GENERATED BY THE HIGH SPEEDS, BUT AT THE SAME TIME PROVIDE CONSIDERABLE STABILITY, GRIP AND AGILITY

Last year the race took place under cloudy skies, which kept track temperatures very low for August. Despite this, the tires worked very well with most of the riders using our Medium compound tires front and rear for the race, although Fabio won the race with a Soft front, showing the versatility of the allocation.

Apart from the weather, technically the circuit is not an easy one for the tires

due to the mix of the high speeds reached on the straights combined with the very fast corners. For these reasons, we will bring an allocation of tires that can not only resist the heat generated by the high speeds, but at the same time provide considerable stability, grip and agility needed to give the riders the confidence to attack the fast direction changes on each lap.

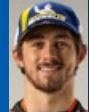

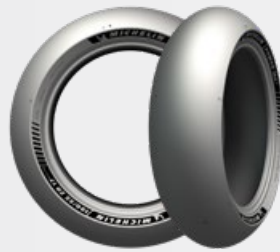
