### 12 Power rear slicks

- ✓ Up to 6 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 4 Power Slick Hard



Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2:

- ✓ + 1 MICHELIN Front Power Slick (of the specification the riders prefer)
- ✓ 1 MICHELIN Rear Power Slick Soft

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tyres allocated will be rain tyres.

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tyre will be allocated.

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tyres will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tyres, and 8 Rear rain tyres.

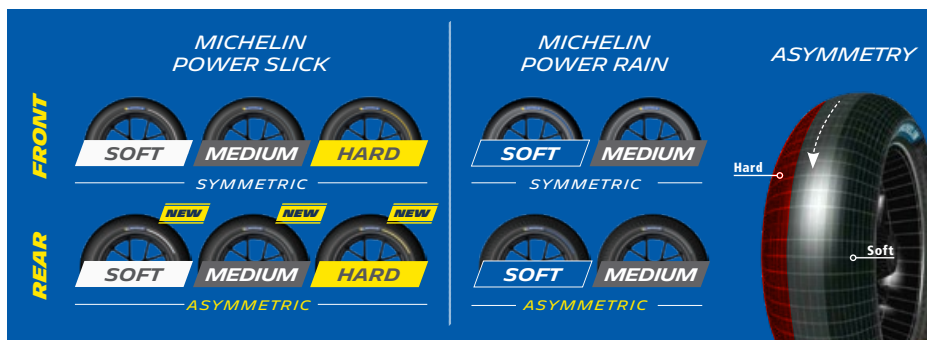

"Brno is usually the circuit we head to after the summer break, so it will feel strange going there as only the second

venue of the season. All the protocols that worked so well in Jerez are still in place in Brno, so it will seem strange not seeing the large areas around the track full of people on raceday, but we will be determined to put on a good show for all the fans watching at home. We had a good start to the season in

Spain, we broke some records and the new tyres performed very well in the extreme conditions. Brno is a wide track and has lots of hard accelerating sectors that need a lot of grip from the rear to give the riders the best propulsion possible, this is something our new rear tyres have been designed for, so it will be good to see them perform at a track that is ideal for their characteristics."
