

"The Circuit of the Americas always represents a bit of a step into the unknown for riders, as the track evolves from one year to the next. Its surface is aggressive,

exacerbated by repeated efforts to smooth out the bumps, which have created lots of tiny grooves in the asphalt. That makes COTA one of the most punishing stops on the MotoGP™ calendar for the front tires, which is why we will take the same range to Texas as we took

to Argentina. By contrast, it is not so tough on the rears, hence the choice of Soft and Medium there – both asymmetric to suit the circuit's characteristics."

"The flow of the corners and the high speeds also generate plenty of heat in the tires, while putting riders under considerable physical strain – and that will be even more the case this year with the new Saturday sprint race in addition to Sunday's grand prix."





