



In the case that any 3 of the 5 sessions, being P1, P2, Free Practice, one Qualifying session, and the Sprint (always excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

"The aim of our selection for the French Grand Prix is not only to provide the riders with a high-performance package but also to ensure they feel confident over the three

days," says Piero Taramasso, the manager of Michelin's two-wheel programmes. "The track isn't all that abrasive here, but we have chosen to strengthen the right side of the rear tires because there are twice as many right-hand turns at Le Mans-Bugatti as there are left-handers. In keeping with this year's regulations, only two compounds will be available for the rear. There is always a

chance of cold weather at Le Mans at this time of the year, so our Soft MICHELIN Power Slick will be ideal for such a scenario because it works well at low temperatures.

The Medium alternative is particularly versatile, especially in warmer weather, so that option will cover the other conditions. This is our home race, so we will obviously be under a little more pressure than usual, but I'm convinced that the 1,000th MotoGP grand prix will be a big success. The grandstands are going to be packed and it's going to be a huge weekend for the fans!"





MotoE[™] enters an exciting new era with more races in 2023 by officially achieving FIM World Championship status. The 2023 season welcomes a new single manufacturer, Ducati. Michelin continues its commitment by providing even more environmentally friendly and high performance tires.





MICHELIN POWER TIRES FOR THE 2023 CHAMPIONSHIP

For 2023, Michelin has developed a new front and new rear tire that now incorporate **34 and 52 percent sustainable raw materials** respectively. These two tires take their inspiration from the brand's MotoGP^M range and are designed to match the characteristics of the new allelectric Ducati bikes that will feature in this year's series.

SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS

To make its MotoE[™] tires, Michelin employs an extensive palette of biosourced and recycled sustainable raw materials, including:

- Hevea latex (natural rubber)
- Used truck and car tires (Enviro rCB)
- Orange and lemon peel (limonene resin)
- Pine-tree resin
- 🗸 Sunflower oil
- Recycled scrap steel

Aim: Reducing the impact on the planet's resources while meeting the safety and performance requirements of competition tires.

ALLOCATION

A single front rear pairing

- ✓ Exceptional versatility: just one combination of front and rear tires to cover all the circuits visited by the 2023 series.
- High performance: a revised materials-specification, yet superior performance compared with 2022
- Grip: grip performance from Turn 1, Lap

- Riders who participate in both QP1 and QP2 qualifying sessions (maximum 2 riders) will be allocated one extra rear slick tire after QP2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 5 rear new slick tires).
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that QP1 and QP2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

"We are delighted to see how MotoE[™] is evolving in 2023, including the introduction of new, highperformance Ducati bikes. Michelin has worked handin-hand with Ducati to deliver an unprecedented level of performance for this all-electric series. Pre-season testing confirmed the progress that has been made, with lap times at Jerez and Barcelona down by three seconds. These results were achieved, I stress, with the contribution of tires that contain an even higher proportion of sustainable materials, in perfect keeping with the Michelin Group's strategy.

"The 2023 MotoE[™] season promises to be very busy, with 16 races over eight weekends and the involvement of quality teams and riders. We will work with them all very closely throughout the campaign, from the mid-May opener at Le Mans [France] until the finale at Misano [Italy] on September 10."

Two practice sessions (15 minutes) on Friday



Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.



Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.
