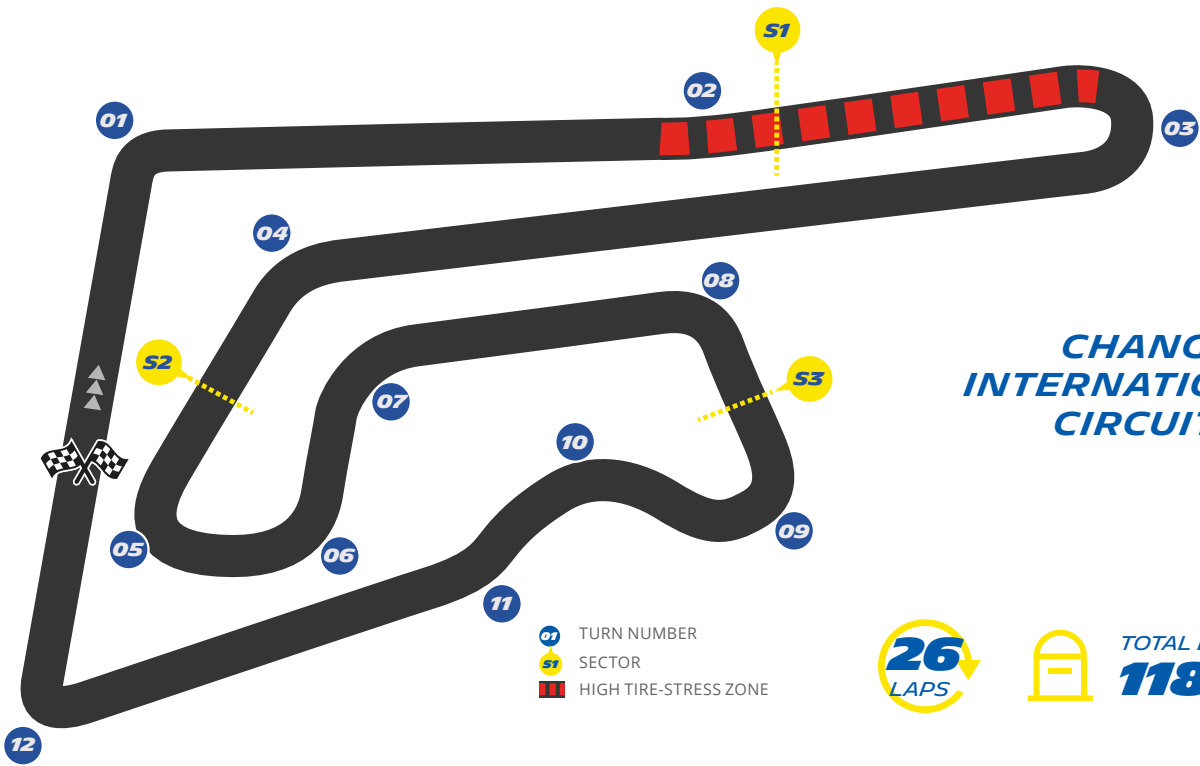

In the case that any 3 of the 5 sessions, being P1, P2, Free Practice, one Qualifying session, and the Sprint (always excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tires will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tires, and 8 Rear rain tires.

WE HAVE REINFORCED THE CASING OF THE REAR TIRES TO CONTROL TEMPERATURE PEAKS

As part of the 2023 regulations, we have selected two rear compounds instead of three. So, in addition to the Soft, Medium and Hard compounds for the front, we have brought Medium and Hard compounds for the rear, with a harder compound on the right side of the tread. We have also reinforced the casing of the rear tires to control temperature peaks. The air temperature will surely rise above 30°C, which means track temperatures of more than 45°C, but it is above all the layout of the circuit, similar to

that of the Red Bull Ring in Austria, which encouraged us to use this particular internal structure for the rear tires. The benefit of this

technical choice is to provide more stability for the riders when the tire is subjected to high stresses, on the straights and under hard acceleration. Thus prepared, we are confident that the versatility of the Hard compound and the ultimate performance of the Medium compound will cover all the needs of our partners.

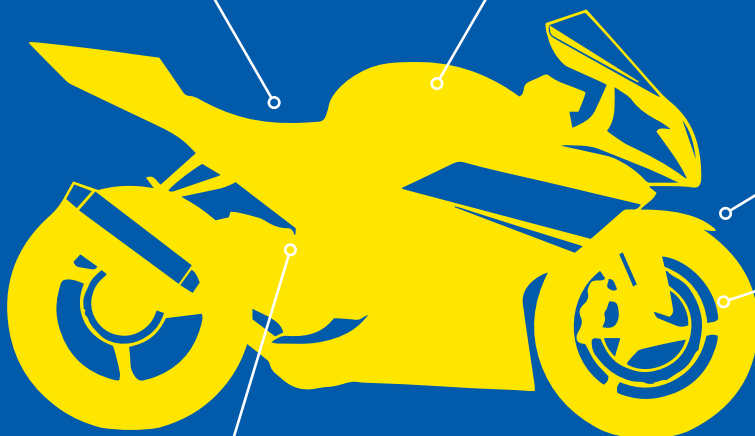
