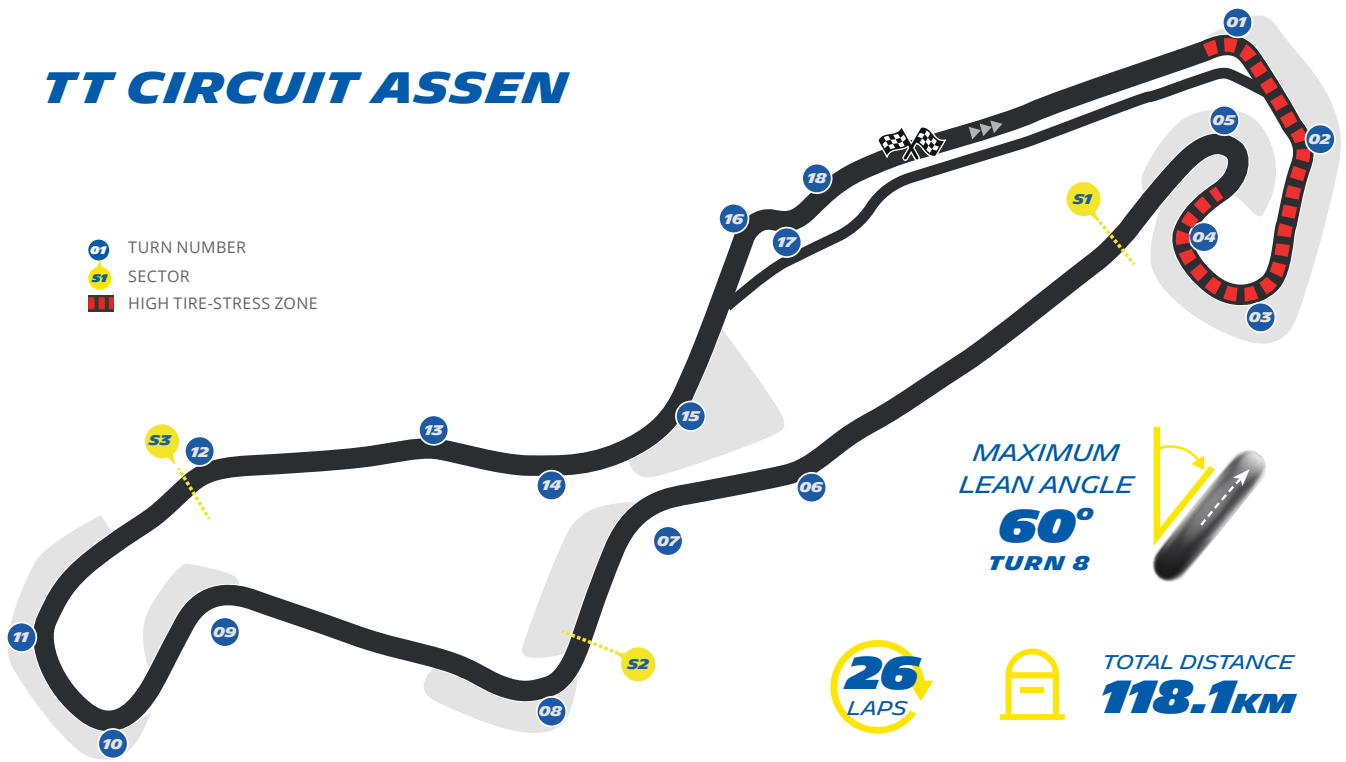

The surface is not very abrasive but the track is very fast, especially in the sequences of the second part. Based on the data we recorded over the last few years (the asphalt was redone in 2020), we have decided to revise the Hard front rubber compound. The Soft and Medium compounds will be the same as last year, but the Hard will be a little harder - a little more rigid. We are also responding to the fact that the motorcycles are a little more aggressive on their front tires. The fronts will all be symmetrical, but the two rear compounds (Soft and Medium) will be reinforced on the right side, to compensate for the greater number of turns in this direction.

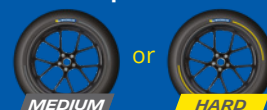

Michelin has been the FIM MotoE™ World Championship's sole tyre supplier since the all-electric competition was first organised in 2019. The Group sees this highly competitive series as a full-scale research and development laboratory where it can explore and test technological innovations in exacting conditions. Not only have the unique opportunities for innovation that MotoE™ offers seen Michelin increase the proportion of renewable and recycled raw materials that its tyres for the championship contain, but they are also speeding up the emergence of specific solutions for tomorrow's electric motorcycles and scooters.

Michelin sees MotoE™ as a means to accelerate innovation as it prepares for tomorrow's world of two-wheel mobility, with powerful analysis and smart data at the heart of its development processes.

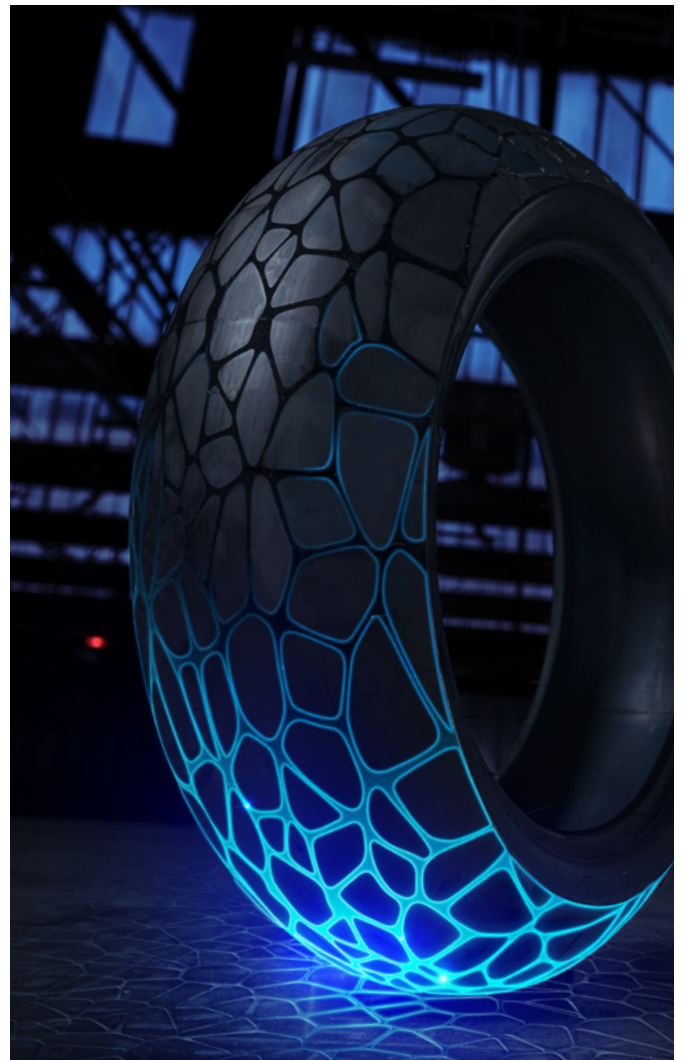
A NEW DESIGN FOR THE REAR TIRE

The MICHELIN MotoE range of tires contains 49 and 53 percent renewable and recycled materials front and rear respectively, compared with 34 and 52 percent in 2023.

- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tires allocated will be rain tires.
- In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions then no extra tire will be allocated.

QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Q1: the slowest 10 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2.

Q2: the fastest 8 riders from the combined results of FP1 and FP2 plus the fastest 2 riders from Q1.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts. Tire warmers may be used on the grid. Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted.

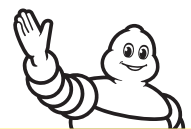
