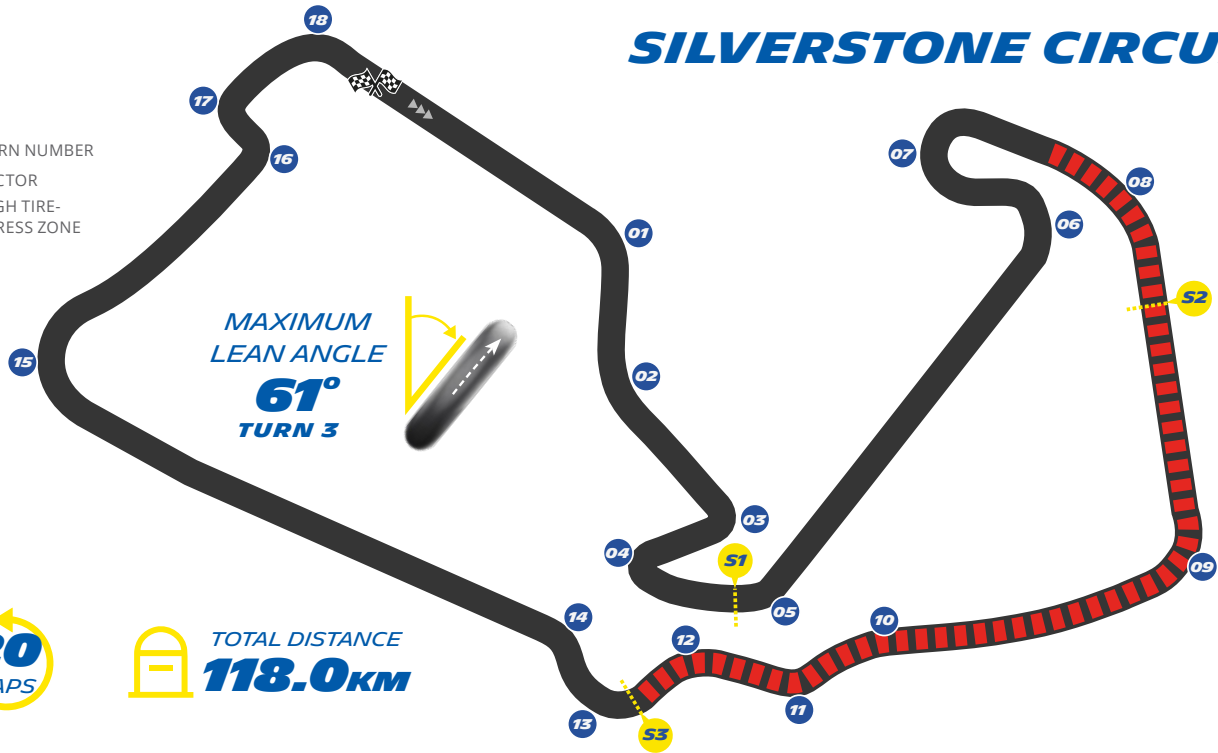

The Silverstone circuit is not only the longest of the season, but it is also one of the fastest. The sequences of high-speed turns form the DNA of this legendary venue, which I compare a little to Assen in the Netherlands, where we went in June. The grip level is good, but the asphalt, which was resurfaced in 2019, is not very abrasive and the level of wear is measured. Silverstone is nevertheless a track which puts a lot of stress on the front tires because the braking here is more violent than on many other circuits. In addition, the acceleration forces generate heavy loads on the rear tires, which must withstand this significant stress. I should also highlight the meteorological uncertainty, because our records show significant variations over the years, but this doesn't worry us because our tires are versatile. We selected the same compounds as last year, with the exception of the Hard compound front which is now harder, in order to respond to the technical and aerodynamic developments of the motorcycles. Since the start of the season the riders have broken numerous records, and it is of course because their bikes are more efficient, but also because Michelin has been able to support them with tires that allow them to exploit the full potential of their machines.

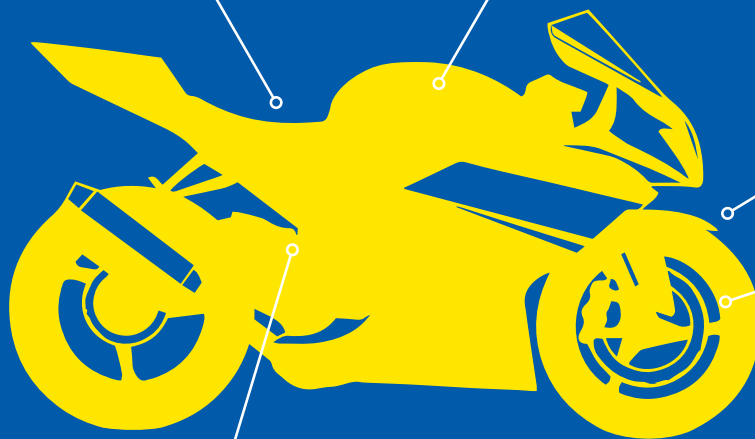


