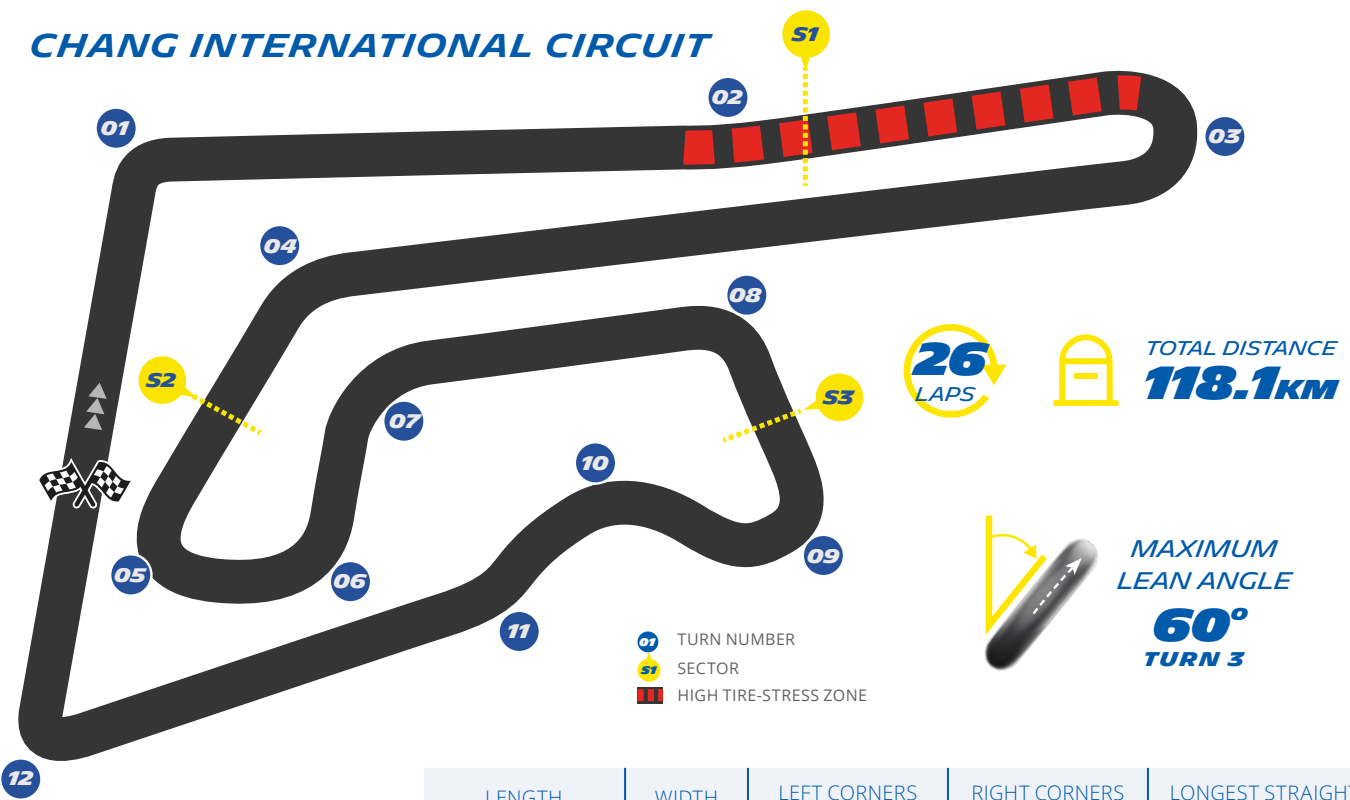

The level of performance we saw here just a year ago led us to re-use the same types of tires, but with some adjustments to the front tires. Last year, thanks to a particularly well-adapted package, we witnessed an exceptional show with some great battles on the track.

Given this performance and the records broken all over the world since the start of the season, we have increased the rigidity of the three front tire compounds slightly, and also strengthened the internal structure of the Hard compound. The rear tires were already in this configuration last year, so we are re-using them as is. Whether it's grip, traction, braking stability or wear, we have to provide tires that will work well in all areas. In the 2023 Tissot Spint, with 45°C track temperatures (30°C air) and 60% humidity, almost all of our partners chose Medium compound MICHELIN Power Slicks for both the front and rear, and they worked very well. On the Sunday, all riders (except Alex Marquez) chose a Hard compound rear, and we witnessed a splendid Grand Prix, with many changes of position and constant attacks. And with our 2024 allocation, we believe that the spectacle will be repeated this year!

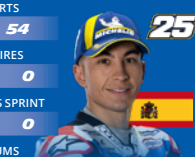

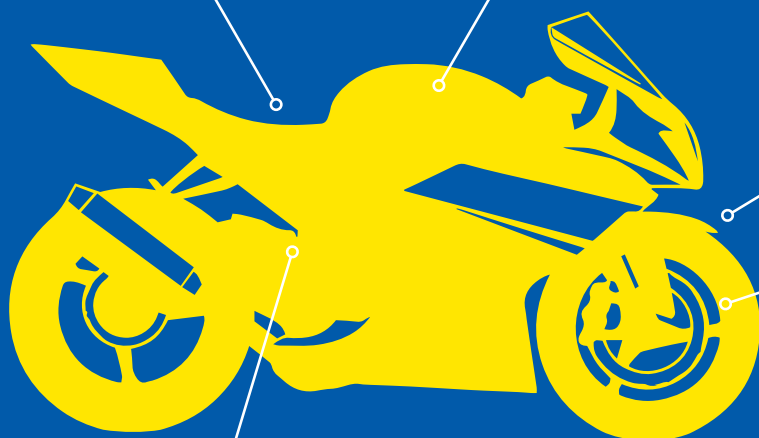
