


MICHELIN STATISTIC

After six years of Toyota domination, there will be a different Hypercar FIA World Endurance Champion in 2025 - Ferrari, Porsche or Cadillac. With a maximum of 66 Manufacturers' points up for grabs in Bahrain, Ferrari (204 points) tops the provisional standings, ahead of Porsche (165) and Cadillac (143). Michelin has previously won three FIA WEC titles with Porsche (2015/2016/2017), a Formula 1 world title with Ferrari (1979) and three IMSA titles with Cadillac (2020/2021/2023).

ENDURANCE RACING: AN INNOVATION ACCELERATOR FOR **MICHELIN**

Michelin sees motorsport general, and the FIA World **Endurance Championship** (FIA) particular, as a means to accelerate innovation. The proportion of renewable and recycled materials that go into the MICHELIN Pilot Sport endurance-racing rain tire stands at 45 percent.

In 2021, Michelin presented a demonstration tire containing

46 percent recycled/renewable raw materials for the MissionH24 hydrogen fuel-cell racing prototype. The rain tires used by today's Hypercar prototypes incorporate 45 percent renewable or recycled raw materials.

Motorsport is one of the driving forces behind Groupe Michelin's Everything Sustainable plan for 2050.

Sakhir International Circuit's particularly abrasive surface makes it one of the FIA WEC's toughest venues in terms of tire wear. Careful management during the cars' second stints is therefore crucial, especially the lefts. When the track

temperature is between 30 °C and 40 °C, choosing between the medium and hard compounds is of key strategic importance because you need to strike a delicate balance

between consistency, grip and fast warm-up performance. The rear tires face big demands during the repeated re-acceleration out of the slow turns which accentuates their thermal degradation. In addition, some of the braking zones –

especially into Turns 1, 4, 11 and 14 – are among the most demanding on the calendar and require rigorous energy and brake-cooling management.



BAHRAIN TRIVIA

Bahrain is a Persian Gulf archipelago made up of 33 islands.

The name Bahrain is from the Arabic for 'two seas'.

The main island is connected to Saudi Arabia by the King Fahd Causeway.

Since antiquity, Bahrain has been renowned for pearl fishing. The Pearling Path includes 17 UNESCO-listed buildings in Muharraq dedicated to pearl fishing history.

Inaugurated in 1988, the Bahrain National Museum relates the kingdom's rich history.


Bahrain's capital Manama is situated in the north of the country

Sakhir is situated in a central desert region (92% of the country is desert).

Sakhir Palace is a huge palace near Zallag built in 1901.





MICHELIN AND BARRAN

- » In 2004, Bahrain became the first Gulf state to host a Formula 1 grand prix. Fifteen cars contested the race on Michelin tires.
- » Michelin locked out the 2005 F1 GP podium in Bahrain with Renault, Toyota and McLaren.
- » Michelin won the Bahrain Grand Prix in 2006 with Fernando Alonso (Renault).
- » Audi, Porsche and Toyota have all won endurance races in Bahrain with Michelin.
- » All of Toyota's different FIA WEC prototypes have won in Bahrain on Michelin tires.
- » A Michelin-partnered Porsche Carrera Cup Middle-East race is also on the bill in Bahrain.
- A Rookie Test will be held at Sakhir International Circuit on November
 Oliver Gray, 20, will get his first drive in the world championship-winning Hypercar on MICHELIN Pilot Sport tires.

The maximum number of dryweather tires that can be used during a Competition is defined as follows:

- For free practice sessions, from the beginning of the practice sessions.
- For the qualifying session and the race, from the start of the qualifying session.
- For the Hyperpole from the start of the session. Tires allocated for Hyperpole must be used only and exclusively for the Hyperpole session.
- -To go from the pit lane to the starting grid before the start of the race, the tires used can be either dry-weather tires or wetweather tires and will not be counted in the allocation.
- At the start of a Competition, any dry weather tires used must be new.

WET-WEATHER TIRES

The number of wet-weather tires usable during a Competition is not limited.

During practices and the race, wetweather tires can only be used once the track has been declared wet by the Clerk of the Course / Race Director.

Tires for wet weather may have been already used and must be of the specification declared by the tire manufacturer.

OTHER FACTS

Any process that involves a direct or indirect attempt at modifying the temperature of a tire (compared to the ambient temperature) is forbidden.

Use of storage tents in designated areas is permitted only if they are always ventilated with ambient air and accessible.

Infringement of the tire allowance: Stop & Go of 2 minutes per tire.

Infringement of the tire heating rules: Stop & Go of 3 minutes during the race.

Four mechanics and two tire guns allowed for wheel changes during pit stops. Wheel changes are only allowed when the car is not being refueled.

Only one tire technician is allowed to measure tire temperatures and pressures.

Tire changes may only be carried out on the starting grid up to the five-minute board, in front of the garage or inside the garage if significant work is being undertaken on the car, on the track in the case of a suspension of the race.

Each tire must be identified by RFID and barcode. All references must be declared to the Technical Delegate at least 48 hours before the start of the Competition.
