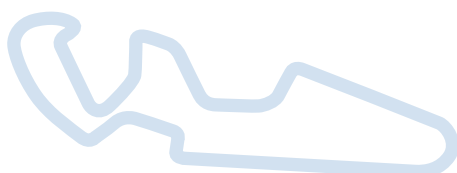

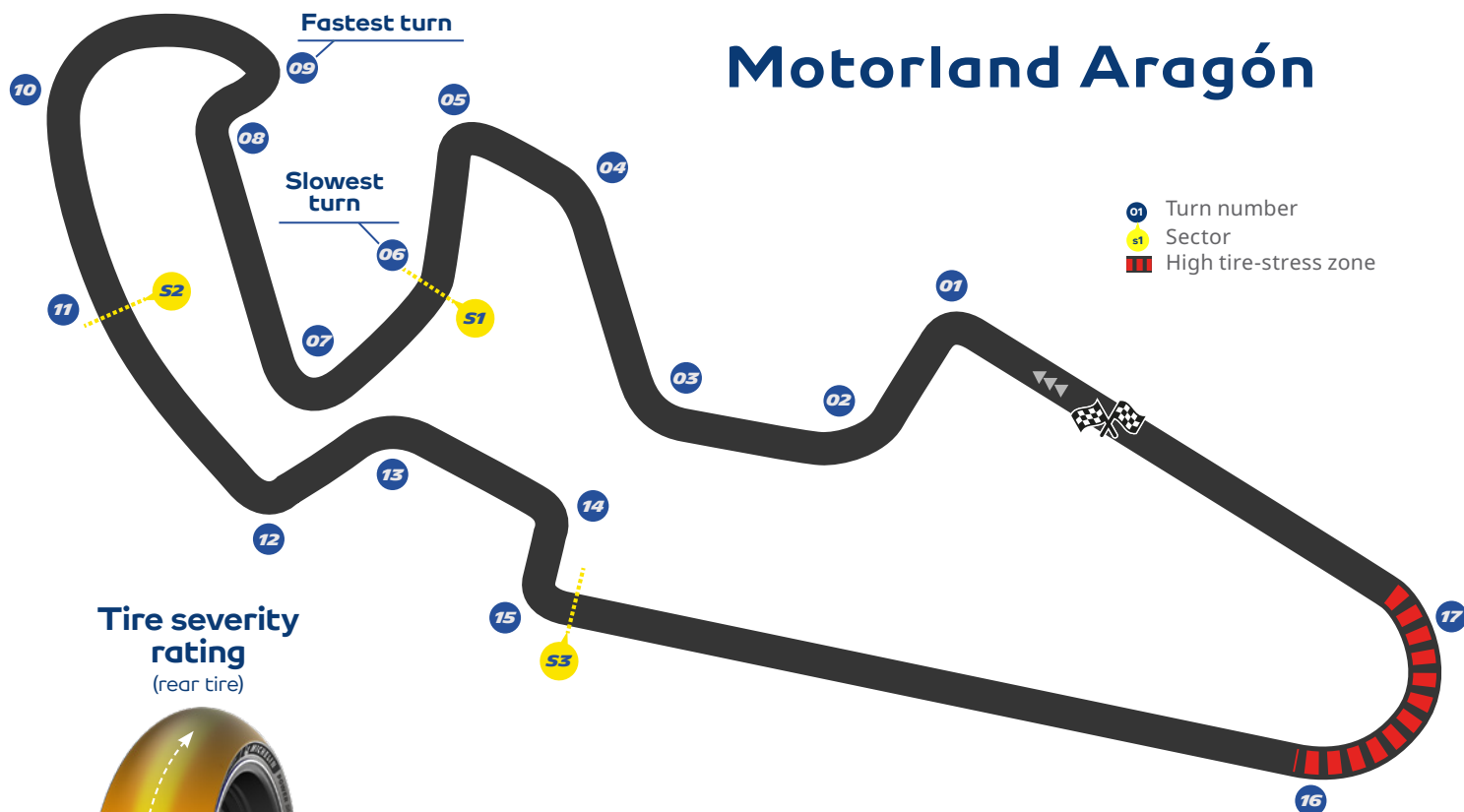

The tire combinations for the weekend's two races have not yet been finalised

Last June, the track temperature had already exceeded 50 °C, and we expect even higher figures this year. MotorLand Aragón is an unusual circuit, run anti-clockwise, with long straights where speeds are very

high. Its undulating profile and tight corners make it particularly demanding for the riders, the bikes and the tires. Tire temperatures rise rapidly here, which accelerates wear. We have therefore taken

the necessary measures to manage this, including in areas where the track can be contaminated by debris regularly blown in by the wind. The tire combinations for the weekend's two races have not yet been finalised. However, the choices that were overwhelmingly favoured in 2025 — Medium at the front and Soft at the rear for the Tissot Sprint, followed by Medium at both the front and rear for the Grand Prix — could well prevail again this year.
